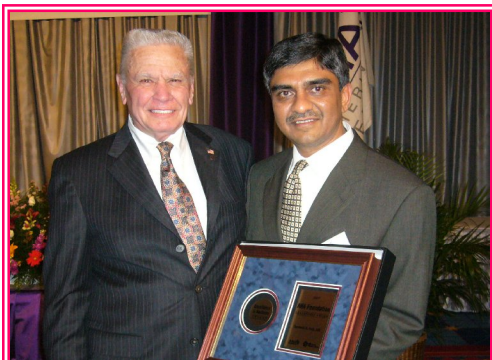


Dr. Harmesh Naik Honored by American Medical Association Excellence in Medicine Award
