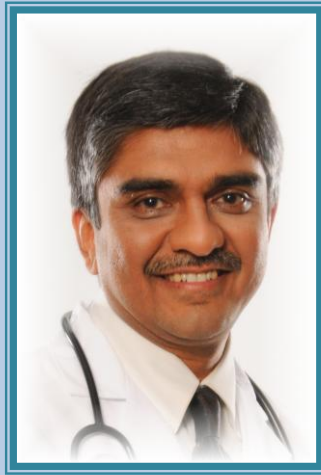


Dr. Harmesh Naik Selected by the Commission on Cancer

He plans to obtain necessary training in upcoming months and expects to start his program surveyor duties in 2012. A physician program surveyor is responsible for auditing accredited cancer programs around the country for monitoring and improving quality of cancer care per standards established by the Commission on Cancer.

The Commission on Cancer is a national consortium of organizations dedicated to improving quality of life and survival of cancer patients. It was established by the American College of Surgeons in 1922. The multi-disciplinary Commission establishes the standards to ensure quality, conducts surveys to assess compliance and develops effective interventions to improve cancer care.

Dr. Naik has been involved in cancer program accreditation activities for over 10 years. He has gathered extensive experience in program standards and multi-disciplinary care for cancer patients. Dr. Naik strongly believes the nationwide program standards to be important tools to improve cancer care quality and to directly benefit patient care. In his new role, he plans to continue pursuing these goals.
